Passage: Romans 11:33-36

1. Ice Breaker: How has this connect group been a blessing in your life?
2. Read Romans 11:33-36. What word does this passage begin with? What do you think Paul means to communicate with this strong interjection?
3. Consider the context of Romans 9-11 (God's wisdom/sovereignty in the salvation/preservation of His people). How do you think this plays into Paul's exclamatory statements in verse 33?
4. How would you define worship (as a verb)? How much of your life should be spent in worship? Consider Matthew 22:37. How does Wellsboro Bible Church's mission statement promote worship?
5. What does verse 33 say about God's character? How does this motivate a response of worship?
6. How would you answer the question posed in verses 34? How does this declaration of God's wisdom motivate a response of worship?
7. According to verse 35, everything belongs to God. How does this change the way we think about our "possessions?" If we can't give God a gift, why do we tithe? What needs to change about the way you are caring for the possessions God has entrusted to you?
8. Read verse 36. What does it mean that all things are from God? Through Him? To Him? How can you glorify God 24/7/365? What about your life is not glorifying to God? Why? Are you willing to change? How?
