

How God's People Treat God's People

1. Read Colossians 3 and Acts 2
2. What does it mean to be raised with Christ? Consider Colossians 2:6 and Philippians 3:1-10. Have you been raised with Christ?
3. What does it mean to seek the things above? What imagery does Christ seated at the right hand of God convey? What are some things in this world that might distract us from being more kingdom minded?
4. According to verses 5 – 11, what are Christians to “put off?” What is the central theme of this section?
5. What equality statement is made in verse 11? How does this impact you? How does this inform your view of Christians who are very different from you? Who you have a hard time getting along with?
6. According to verses 12 – 17, what are Christians to “put on?” Why is love superior to the other characteristics?
7. In what ways have you been shown love by other Christians? What do you do when you feel unloved? What do you do when you don't feel like loving others?
8. Is there anyone in the church you have a complaint against? What does this passage instruct you to do? On what basis? How much did Christ forgive you?
9. What is the role of singing in the body of Christ? What is the reason for this singing? What supports this singing?
10. Read Colossians 3:17 out loud. Has this been the pattern of your day? Week? Month? Life? What evidence supports this? What can you do if you're not living this way?
11. Summarize how God's people should treat one another. Summarize how you should treat God's people. What action will you take?
