Scripture Reading

3 among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.

4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ— by grace you have been saved—

6 and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, 7 so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

Opening Questions:

1. What is something in your life we can celebrate with you? How can we praise God for the work He is doing in your life? (Please be brief)
2. Name one thing you have learned about someone in your group (make sure that person wouldn't mind you sharing!!)

Sermon Questions:

1. Read Matthew 28:18-20. Why do you think Jesus establishes His authority? What is the scope of this authority? How does Christ's authority impact your life? Your neighbor's life? Your unsaved friend's life? A Muslim's life? Is there anyone it does not impact?
2. What is a disciple? Consider the call of the disciples in Matthew 4:18-20. What were they called to do? What did it cost them? Explain what you had to give up in order to become a disciple of Christ. What did you gain? What is now your greatest desire?
3. What has Christ commanded His disciples to do in Matthew 28:18-20? Why do many Christians neglect this responsibility? Is a Christian who neglects this responsibility fully following Christ? Are your priorities consistent with the priorities of one who is following Jesus? If not, what can you do? What if you won't?
4. Write down the names of 5 people you know who need Christ. Are you willing to go to them in obedience to Christ? Pray for these people each week and seek opportunities to point share the good news of the gospel with them. Share 1 with the group.
5. Write down the names of 5 people in the church you can encourage in the faith. How will you help them grow as disciples of Christ? Is there an excuse not to? Share 1 with the group.
